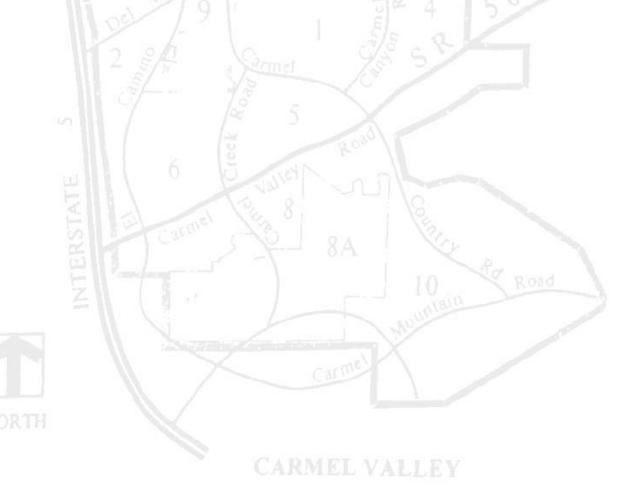

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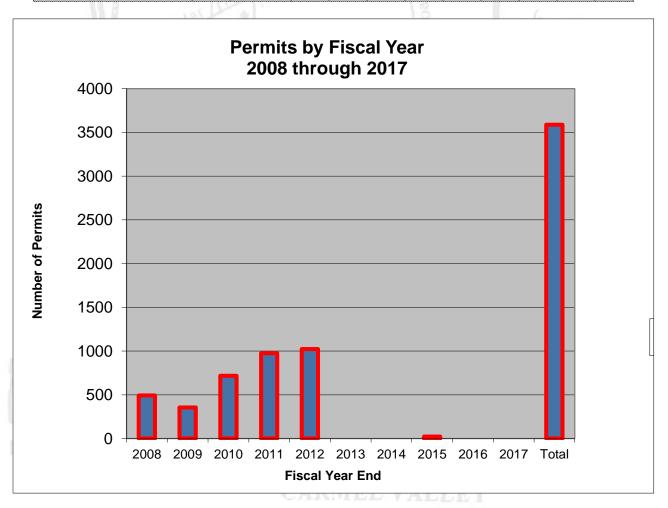

AGREEMENT TO PERFORM INDEPENDENT AUDIT FOR FY 2015-16

BACKGROUND: Wilkinson Hadley King & Co. LLP ("Wilkinson Hadley") has been the JPA/CFD independent auditor for many years. Mr. Michael Mears has been the lead auditor for over ten years, leading staff auditors in the research, analysis and preparation of the financial reports.

The NCW JPA/CFD administration is pleased with the service, thoroughness and consistency of the audit project and recommends placing the next fiscal year's audit contract with Wilkinson Hadley.

The Wilkinson Hadley proposal for the FY 2015-16 has increased to \$6,200, \$200 (3.3%) over the FY 2014-15 fee.

FISCAL IMPACT: Approved budget for FY 2015-16 audit was \$6,200.

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES (UPDATED RATES)

with Best Best & Krieger

BACKGROUND: On August 27, 2007, the North City West JPA entered into an agreement with Best Best & Krieger LLP (BBK) to provide General Counsel Services to the Authority. That original agreement included an increase in the billing rates on June 30 each year using a Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) index that is no longer applicable. Since 2007, BBK has only increased its partner rates by 2.2%, from \$225 to \$230 per hour. A copy of the 2007 agreement in included as Attachment 9B-1

BBK has presented an *Amendment to the Agreement for Legal Services (Updated Rates)* which brings its rates to current levels and amends the annual COLA increase to July 1st of each year based on the San Diego County All Urban Consumer Price Index. The amendment also modifies Exhibit "A" Billing Policies of the agreement reflecting these new rates. A copy of the proposed amendment is included as Attachment 9B-2.

FISCAL IMPACT: BBK billing rates for partner will increase approximately 15% over prior rate, which will impact the FY 2016-17 budget by an estimated \$600-\$1,000.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve Amendment to the Agreement for Legal Services (Updated Rates) with Best Best & Krieger.
